# OTHER ACTIVITIES

#### 10.1 Activities of Vice Chancellor

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Junagadh Agricultural University is responsible for overall administration, development, maintaining discipline and appropriate functioning of the University as per the Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act 2004. The Vice Chancellor has to run the administration as per University rules and regulations. He is also responsible for financial activities of the University. He maintains coordination between Teaching, Research and Extension Education activities conducted by the University. Abrief summary of the activities done by the Vice Chancellor during the year 2012-13 are as under.

Dr. Naginbhai Chandubhai Patel, Principal and Dean of College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology, was appointed as Vice Chancellor of Junagadh Agricultural University, Junagadh by the Government of Gujarat on August 7, 2009 for a period of 5 years. He earned his Bachelor's degree in Agricultural Engineering from College of Technology and Agricultural Engineering, Udaipur (Rajasthan) with first class in 1978 and further pursued his M. Tech. and Ph.D. degrees from premier institute IIT (Indian Institute of Technology), Kharagpur (West Bengal) in the discipline of Agri. Process Engineering in 1980 and 1993, respectively. He made good contribution in Education, Research and Extension. He transformed the University into a robust and well recognized institution by restructuring the departments and modernization of the farms.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor accomplished the mammoth task of improving the education standards and strengthened the departments and laboratories of Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Fisheries and Veterinary Colleges under this University to provide better facilities to the students. Moreover, the state and national level games and sports facilities were acquired for the students. Junagadh Agricultural University has got the facilities like J-GATE and Online Annual Reviews Archives, etc. Further, campus interviews were arranged for outgoing students to avail the employment opportunities in the nationalized banks, corporate and other related organizations.

To satisfy the on field requirements of the farmers of the Saurashtra, the research activities were accelerated by encouraging the scientists involved in research. The research centres were upgraded by developing new infrastructure and getting new schemes. Thus, the concept of Vice Chancellor, to make university activities more and more farmers oriented could be fulfilled. The University organized two meetings of Research Council, i.e., on June 15, 2012 and December 30, 2012 for approval of new research projects and research activities during this year. Under the guidance of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Junagadh Agricultural University, the research projects were carried out successfully with achievement of their targets during the year.

During the year 2012-13, under the HRD component of the University, 95 scientists/teachers were deputed to attend winter/summer school/short term training, 84 faculty members attended different seminar/symposium/conference at state and national level and 147 participated in the workshops and group meets of their projects. The University organized four national level programmes and seven state level programmes like scientists' meets/workshops/seminar/training etc.

### Combined Joint AGRESCO Meeting

During the Ninth Combined Joint AGRESCO meeting, two varieties *viz.*, Cotton (GJC-101) and Sugarcane (GS-5) endorsed for Saurashtra region were released for the state. Besides, 44 technological/ recommendations were made for



farmers and 15 recommendations were made for Scientific Community. In addition, 112 new technical programmes were formulated to initiate the new research for the solutions of the applied and basic problems of agriculture and allied field.

### Krushi Mahotsav-2012

Under the able leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri Narendra Modi, *Krushi Mahotsav*-2012 (May 6-29, 2012) was organized. The Junagadh Agricultural University contributed a lot in successful organization of this programme under the guidance of Dr. N.C. Patel, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Junagadh Agricultural University. Ten khedut shibirs were organised in coordination with APMCs and other local organizations of Saurashtra. Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated a mega event of Krushi Mahotsav-2012 on May 6, 2012 at Manavadar. About 19,063 farmers were benefited by the krushi mela and krushi seminar organised on this occasion.

### 10.2 Activities of Planning Branch

All planning and monitoring related to teaching, research and extension education including budget allocation and monitoring of fund utilization were carried out as under.

#### A. Fund allocation

State Government allocated the funds for teaching, research and extension education programmes of agricultural university as per the requirements of funds for the schemes of various fields as suggested in draft annual plan of the University.

Under the annual development programme (2012-13), initially ₹ 6914.00 lakh were allocated which was revised to ₹ 6695.00 lakh by Govt. of Gujarat for teaching, research and extension education of Junagadh Agricultural University.

For the said purpose, State Government has released ₹ 6669.00 lakh excluding Earmarked for IT. Later, ₹ 25.31 lakh of construction under apple project was surrendered by university to the Government and thus final receipt of grant was ₹ 6643.69 lakh. Out of this amount, ₹ 6220.68 lakh were spent by university and remaining amount was spillover for civil works.

# B. Monitoring

The monthly and quarterly progress reports were collected from the concerned heads of the schemes, which were compiled and submitted to the Government quarterly. The problems of the schemes were solved satisfactorily by discussions between scientists and the Director of Research in two meetings held during the month of December-2012 and March-2013 for evaluation of expenditure of planned schemes and reallocation of the funds, etc.

# 10.3. Development Programme by ICAR for Teaching

Under the scheme on Strengthening and Development of Agricultural Education in State Agricultural Universities, ICAR released a grant of ₹ 399.28 lakh for the year 2012-13. The University utilized ₹ 351.08 lakh from this fund.
