

CHAPTER - 6

STUDENTS' WELFARE

6.1 Director, Students' Welfare:

The Directorate of Students' Welfare, Junagadh Agricultural University is looking after various students' activities, facilities like sports, cultural activities, debate/essay, fellowships, scholarships, residential, recreation, health, adventure, NSS, Students' training, personal training, counseling and placement, *etc.* Moreover, different types of programmes, shibirs/events are conducted among the students and staff by inviting experts of different field.

6.2 Students' Union:

In the colleges of Junagadh Agricultural University, the Student Representative Council (SRC) is constituted by the Principal of respective colleges by selecting the sincere and leading students in sports, culture, debate and adventure activities.

6.3 Students' facilities:

All the undergraduate and post graduate students are provided with 26 hostels for boys and 6

hostels for girls facilities with an attached mess. Various hostel facilities exists for the students of different faculties includingan International hostel for foreign students. In addition to this, a university library withinternet facility, a sport complex, two new play grounds for Kabaddi and Kho-Kho and a multipurpose Indoor Sports Stadium are available for indoor sports.

Students' Counseling and Placement:

The objectives of Student Counseling and Placement cell functioning under the Director, Students' Welfare is to maintain data base of the students of outgoing batch and to keep in constant touch with various employers for conducting campus interview for providing better placement. The Directorate also arrange special lectures and short term training on Personality Development and life skills for the students of all the faculties, so as to, built the self esteem among the students and to face the challenges with confidence.



6.7 Educational Tour:


The Junagadh Agricultural University is conducting the educational tour under RAWE

i. Women's Self Defense Training:

A Surksha Setu Society has been created in the District Police of Junagadh with an aim to organize programme towards young girls/ women's security and strengthening of the society. The NSS JAU, Junagadh made arrangements to participate 105 girls and 5 lady teachers in above programme, as a part of the regular activity of the NSS. This programme was chaired by District Collector, Mr. Alok Kumar Pandey. The theme of the seminar was "Why can't You Be Next?" A live demonstration of the Marshal Art was shown by a trainer.

ii. Launching of Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan (RGKA) with National Youth Policy-2014:

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports,

Govt. of India launched the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan (RGKA) with National Youth Policy-2014 for creating awareness among the youth towards sports, personality development, entrepreneurship, health and education. The Govt. of India suggested to organize certain competitions, such as street plays, debates and students rally in educational institutes of the country.
