



OTHER ACTIVITIES

9.1 Activities of Vice Chancellor

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Junagadh Agricultural University is responsible for overall administration, development, maintaining discipline and appropriate functioning of the University as per the Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act 2004. The Vice Chancellor has to run the administration as per University rules and regulations. He is also responsible for financial activities of the University. He maintains coordination between Teaching, Research and Extension Education activities conducted by the University. A brief summary of the activities done by the Vice Chancellor during 2013-14 are as under.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor accomplished the mammoth task of improving the education standards and strengthened the departments and laboratories of Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Fisheries and Veterinary Colleges under this University to provide better facilities to the students. Moreover, the state and national level games and sports facilities were acquired for the students. Junagadh Agricultural University has got the facilities like J-GATE and Online Annual Reviews Archives *etc.* Further, campus interviews were arranged for outgoing students to avail the employment opportunities in the Nationalized Banks, Corporate and other related organizations.

To satisfy the on field requirements of the farmers of Saurashtra, the research activities were accelerated by encouraging the scientists involved in research. The research centers were upgraded by developing new infrastructure and getting new schemes. Thus, the concept of Vice Chancellor, to make university activities more and more farmers oriented could be fulfilled. The University organized meetings of Research Council *i.e.*, on November 11, 2013 for approval of new research projects and research activities during this year. Under the guidance of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Junagadh

Agricultural University, the research projects were carried out successfully with achievement of their targets during the year.

During the year 2013-14, under the HRD component of the University, 123 scientist/teachers were deputed to attend winter/summer school/short term training, 333 faculty members attended different seminar/symposium/conference at state and national level and 186 participated in the workshops and group meets of their respective projects. The University organized four national level programmes and seven state level programmes like scientists' meets/workshops/seminar/training etc.

Combined Joint AGRESCO Meeting

In the 10th Combined Joint AGRESCO meeting, three varieties *viz.*, Gram (GG-5), Pigeonpea (GJP-1) and Garlic (GJG-5) were released for the state. Besides, 39 technologies /recommendations were made for farmers and 16 recommendations were made for Scientific Community. In addition, 85 new technical programmes were formulated to initiate the new research for the solutions of the applied and basic problems of agriculture and allied field.

9.2 Activities of planning branch

Planning and monitoring related to teaching, research and extension education including budget allocation and monitoring of fund utilization were carried out as under.

9.2.1 Fund allocation

State Government allocated the funds for teaching, research and extension education programmes of agricultural university as per the requirements of funds for the schemes of various fields suggested in draft annual plan of the University.

Under the Annual Development Programme (2013-14), initially ₹ 748.65 lakh were allocated which was revised to ₹ 6888.18 lakh by Govt. of Gujarat for teaching, research and extension education of Junagadh Agricultural University.

Thus, for agricultural education, research and extension education programmes, State Government has released ₹ 6888.18 lakh. Out of this amount, ₹ 7022.21 lakh include expenditure from spill over grant of year 2012-13 expenditure of construction were spent. The unspent amount of ₹ 927.10 lakh allocated towards construction was carried forward as spill over grant, which will be utilized up to December-2014 as per grant in aid rules.

9.2.2 Monitoring

The monthly and quarterly progress reports were collected from the concerned heads of the schemes which were compiled and submitted to the Government quarterly. The problems of the schemes were solved satisfactorily by discussions between scientists and the Director of Research in two meetings held during the month of December-2013 and February-2014 for evaluation of expenditure of planned schemes and reallocation of the funds, *etc*.

9.2.3 Development programme by ICAR for teaching

Under the scheme on Strengthening and Development of Agricultural Education in state agricultural universities, ICAR released a grant of ₹ 423.05 lakh for the year 2013-14, of Which University utilized ₹ 377.50 lakh.
