From the Vice Chancellor's Desk

Biological Control: A Cornerstone of Sustainable Agriculture

Biological control involves the use of living organisms such as predators, parasitoids, pathogens, or antagonists to manage pest populations and plant diseases. The concept dates back to the late 19th century, with the landmark introduction of the vedalia beetle (Rodolia cardinalis) from Australia to California to control cottony cushion scale in citrus - a pioneering success that showcased the power of natural enemies in pest management.



In India, systematic efforts in biological control began in the 1950s under the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). The establishment of the National Bureau of Agricultural Insect Resources (NBAIR), Bengaluru, further strengthened research, conservation, and utilization of beneficial organisms. Over the decades, biocontrol has become an integral part of India's crop protection strategy, in line with global initiatives to reduce dependence on synthetic pesticides. Biological control promotes sustainability and ecological balance by targeting specific pests without harming non-target species. It helps preserve biodiversity, maintain soil health, and provides an eco-friendly solution to challenges such as pesticide resistance, climate change, and environmental degradation.

At Junagadh Agricultural University (JAU), Gujarat, the Department of Entomology has been at the forefront of biocontrol-based Integrated Pest Management (IPM) through research, development, and extensive farmer outreach. The university has established biocontrol laboratories and production units that supply quality cultures of Beauveria bassiana, Lecanicillium lecanii, Metarhizium anisopliae, and parasitoids like Trichogramma chilonis to farmers and extension agencies. Regular training, demonstrations, and awareness programs promote the widespread adoption of bio-based pest management practices.

Collaborative initiatives with ICAR institutes and the Government of Gujarat have expanded the reach of these technologies, leading to significant reductions in pesticide use and improved ecological balance in crops such as cotton, groundnut, and horticultural systems. Through continuous innovation and farmer-centric approaches, JAU has emerged as a leading centre for sustainable pest management in western India.

Biological control stands as a cornerstone of sustainable agriculture, integrating scientific advancement with ecological wisdom. Through its research, production, and extension initiatives, Junagadh Agricultural University continues to champion a greener, safer, and more resilient future for Indian agriculture—where pest management works in harmony with nature

Blood Donation Camp



Celebration of Parthenium Awareness Week

The 20th Parthenium Awareness Week was observed from August 16–22, 2025, across various KVKs of JAU through on-campus and field-level activities to educate farmers on the harmful effects of Parthenium hysterophorus and its management. KVK Targhadia trained over 95 farmers and farm women; KVK Amreli conducted nine programmes reaching 256 participants through trainings, visits, campaigns, lectures, and demonstrations; and KVK Khapat engaged 226 participants through demonstrations,

interactive sessions, and weed removal activities. Together, the KVKs effectively strengthened awareness and promoted practical Parthenium management across the region.



Celebration of Krishi Technology Week

Krishi Technology Week 2025 was celebrated across all KVKs of Junagadh Agricultural University with lectures, demonstrations, exhibitions, and farmer interactions promoting innovative, climate-resilient, and sustainable farming technologies. At Targhadia, 449 farmers and 45 officers benefited from sessions on drought-resistant varieties, IPM, INM, dairy, mechanization, and value addition, inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister Shri Raghavjibhai Patel and senior JAU officials.



KVK Amreli attracted 582 participants through technology exhibitions and value-addition demonstrations, while KVK Khapat engaged 358 farmers with programmes on groundnut technologies, crop management, and natural farming. KVK Pipalia, in collaboration with ATMA, trained 335 participants on climate-resilient practices and soil health, and KVK Nana Kandhasar reached about 500 farmers through expert lectures, exhibitions, and technology unit visits.



KVK Jamnagar concluded the week with 614 participants, receiving guidance on natural farming from JAU's senior leadership. Across campuses, the week strengthened farmer awareness and adoption of modern, sustainable agricultural technologies.


Awards won by UG students
