Report on Veterinary Clinical Camp at Bhanvad (Dt.: 04/02/2018)

A special Veterinary Clinical Camp was organized by Bhanvad Mahajan Panjarapol Gaushala, Bhanvad in collaboration with College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Junagadh Agricultural University and Animal Husbandry Department, Jamnagar district on 4th February, 2018 at Bhanvad, which was sponsored by Shaurastra Prani kalyan Trust. Dr. K. H. Parmar, Dr. Vineetkumar and Dr. V. L. Parmar along with postgraduate students from clinical departments were actively involved in the clinical camp. Sizable number of animals from Bhanvad and surrounding villages were brought for the treatment in the camp. During the camp, one hundred sixty (160) animals were treated for different medical, surgical and gynecological ailments. In the camp different clinical cases were treated such as one hundred forty one (141) Medicines, nine (09) Gynaecology, elevan (11) Surgery. Additionally, nine thousand one hundred fifty (9150) animals were dewormed with anthelmintic and two hundred fifty (1000) animals were direct beneficiaries of the camp. Different species of animals of Bhanvad and surrounding villages got specialized treatment from the expert staff members of the College.
