

Report on Veterinary Clinical Camp at Balagam, Ta. Keshod, Dist. Junagadh (Dt.: 05/02/2020)


A Veterinary Clinical Camp was organized by Gauseva Samaj, Balagam in collaboration with College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry department, Junagadh Agricultural University, Junagadh and Animal Husbandry Department, Gujarat on 5th February, 2020 at Balagam village, Ta. Keshod, Dist. Junagadh. Dr. K. B. Vala, Dr. A. A. Vagh, Dr. R. H. Bhatt, and Dr. K. H. Parmar along with postgraduate students from clinical departments and undergraduate students participated in the clinical camp. Sizable numbers of animals from Balagam and surrounding villages were brought for the treatment in the camp. During the camp, One hundred four (104) animals were treated for different medical, surgical and gynecological ailments. In the camp different clinical cases were treated such as fifty three (53) medicinal cases, eight (08) Surgical cases and forty three (43) cases of Gynaecology. Additionally, three thousand nine hundred forty five (3945) animals were dewormed with anthelmintic. A total of one hundred fifty eight (158) livestock owners were direct beneficiaries of the camp. Different species of animals of Balagam and surrounding villages got specialized treatment from the expert staff members of the College.
