Report on Veterinary Clinical Camp at Taravada, Dist. - Amreli (Dt.: 24/02/2016)

A Veterinary Clinical Camp was organized by College of Agriculture, Amreli in collaboration with College of Veterinary Science & A.H., Junagadh Agricultural University and Animal Husbandry Department, Amreli district on 24th February, 2016 at Tarvada, Amreli. Dr. J. S. Patel, Dr. J. V. Vadaliya, Dr. R. J. Raval, and Dr. B. J. Thakre along with five under graduate and two postgraduate students from clinical departments were actively involved in the clinical camp. Sizable number of animals from Taravada and surrounding villages were brought for the treatment in the camp. During the camp, three hundred three (303) animals were treated for different medical, surgical and gynaecological ailments. In the camp different clinical cases were treated such as thirty two (32) Medicines, eighteen (18) Gynaecology, three (03) Surgery. Additionally, two hundred fifty (250) animals were dewormed with anthelmetic and one hundred two (102) animals were vaccinated. A total forty seven (47) livestock owners were direct beneficiaries of the camp. Different species of animals of Tarvada and surrounding villages got specialized treatment from the expert staff members of the college.
